LONG-TERM CARE IN SKILLED NURSING

The Skilled Nursing team at Reformed Church Home takes great pride in a long history of dignified and compassionate senior care in an exceptionally maintained setting! We offer complete nursing care for long-term residents in conjunction with an award-winning staff, which has been recognized over many years for 5-star quality of care and outstanding state survey performance.

Our Skilled Nursing center can accommodate 108 individuals, with the majority being permanent, long-term care residents. Most of these residents require full assistance with normal activities of daily living, such as dressing, bathing, feeding, toileting, and/or require more complex nursing care. About one-third of the beds are dedicated to short-term stays for our sub-acute rehabilitation program.

Care Team Members

Skilled Nursing residents are cared for by a highly trained, compassionate staff that provides a wide range of personal and health-related services. All of our residents are under the care of our Medical Director, Edward Mezic, MD, who makes referrals to specialists as needed. Other team members include: Registered and Licensed Practical Nurses, Nurse Practitioner, Certified Nursing Assistants, an



ordained Reformed Church (Christian) Minister, activities director and staff, dietitian, and licensed social workers.

Visiting Doctors And Healthcare Providers

In addition to our Medical Director, a podiatrist, optometrist, dentist, psychiatrist, and psychologist regularly visit our community. Physical, occupational, and speech therapists are on site 7 days per week.

SKILLED NURSING RATES AND SERVICES

ong-term nursing care requires an application be completed along with a \$50 application fee. Medical and financial information must be reviewed prior to acceptance. Monthly rates for Skilled Nursing include all resident services (see page 6); rates are determined by the specific room style chosen.

Our spacious, thoughtfully-designed rooms allow considerable privacy; conveniences such as telephone service, wireless internet, and satellite TV service* are also included in the monthly rate.






SKILLED NURSING FLOOR PLANS

SERVICES INCLUDED IN THE DAILY FEE

ong-term nursing care includes many services and amenities that make life more enjoyable for our residents while providing them with the outstanding health-care services they require, including:

• A fully furnished residence including window treatments



- Full nursing care and medication management
- Personal assistance by Certified Nurses Aides with activities of daily living
- Call-bell system for additional assistance
- Ongoing health monitoring
- Three nutritious meals per day, with a registered dietitian on staff
- Housekeeping and laundry
- A full calendar of daily activities and events
- Library with a variety of large print books
- All utilities including phone service and wireless internet
- Satellite television service
- Ability to control heat and air conditioning per room
- Maintenance and repair services
- Landscaped grounds and garden
- Full generator support during power outages

- Personal expenses during offsite shopping and lunch trips
- Physical, occupational, and speech rehabilitation services in our fully equipped therapy center (may be covered by Medicare or private insurance)



RESPITE STAYS AT REFORMED CHURCH HOME

Respite is a short-term stay in a fully furnished private or semi-private room. Residents enjoy all of the services and amenities included in permanent residency, while the family has peace of mind.

Respite Stays Are Ideal Solutions When:

- The caregiver is planning a vacation and wants to ensure a safe and caring environment for a loved one while away
- The senior is being discharged from a rehab or nursing facility and needs short-term assistance with daily activities before returning home
- He or she wants to "try out" our community before making a final decision to stay long term

Skilled Nursing Respite Costs And Terms

We ask that our Skilled Nursing respite residents stay for a minimum of one week. Some residents return home after respite ends while others choose to apply for permanent, long-term care.

Respite residents pay a \$362 (semi-private) or \$403 (private) daily fee based on the room style available/desired. Full payment for the anticipated period is due prior to admission.
